

Getting Here

If you are using Sat Nav

If you are using a Sat Nav make sure you put in Glenorchy Farm, PA33 1BD otherwise you will end up in the middle of the Glen!

If you are arriving from the North (Fort William)

Drive through Bridge of Orchy on the A82 and after a mile or so you will see a sign to Glen Orchy. Turn right down this road (B8074) into Glen Orchy - further notes below.

If you are arriving from the South (Stirling/Glasgow roads)

Drive through Tyndrum, if you are using a Sat Nav it may try to get you to turn onto the A84 to Oban, don't do this but carry on North towards Fort William. Go over the hill, down the far side and just before you reach Bridge of Orchy take the signed road to the left down Glen Orchy.

Once in the Glen our Farm is 4 miles down the single track road. Take your time driving here as there is lots of wildlife - deer, badgers, otters, foxes, pine martens and in the autumn lots of woodcock arrive on our road for 2-3 days before dispersing. Also in the spring after the rain and in the dark there are 1000s of frogs/toads on the road - I drive ridiculously slowly trying to avoid them all. Also there may be other cars coming the other direction so give yourself plenty time to stop. When you reach our farm you will see pig arcs and maybe pigs in the fields on your left. The Cabins are on your left at the far end of the fields. Keep driving across a little bridge and you will see the farm shed and house on your left. Follow the road around the corner and our entrance is there.

If you are driving from the West (Oban)

Drive through Dalmally and head towards Tyndrum, after a couple of miles you will cross a bridge and there is a sign for Glen Orchy - turn left onto this road (B8074). This is a single track road that will lead you to our farm. Drive up this road for 8 miles and as mentioned above watch out for wildlife and other cars. You will pass the Bailey bridge (about 4-5 miles) which if you have time is worth a stop at the car park as the waterfalls here are magnificent. Keep driving and the forest will open out to fields - you may see some pigs, cows or sheep in the fields. You will pass our neighbours house on your right, keep driving and you will come up to a little steep hill at the top you will be looking directly at the farmhouse. At the bottom of the hill turn right into our drive.

Once on the Farm

Please drive slowly here as there are feral children, hens, guinea fowl, dogs, cats and occasionally horses wandering about. Pass the Farm House on your right, drive up through the sheds bearing right and follow the track past the polytunnel and over the bridge. Follow this track up the hill and over the Cattle Grid into the Cabin area. You will see the Cabins in front of you now. Tom Carr on the left and Lairig on the Right.
